

On November 15, 2024, Khwaja Fareed University of Engineering and Information Technology (KFUEIT), in collaboration with the International Water Management Institute (IWMI), inaugurated the state-of-the-art Eddy Covariance Flux Tower on November 15, 2024. This cutting-edge facility is designed to revolutionize climate and agricultural research by providing real-time data for climate monitoring, enabling precise weather forecasting, and helping farmers mitigate climate-related risks to their crops. The Eddy Covariance Flux Tower serves as a vital instrument for analyzing energy, water, and carbon exchanges between the land surface and the atmosphere. Its insights are expected to significantly enhance water resource management, improve agricultural practices, and reduce the impact of natural disasters on the region's farming communities.
