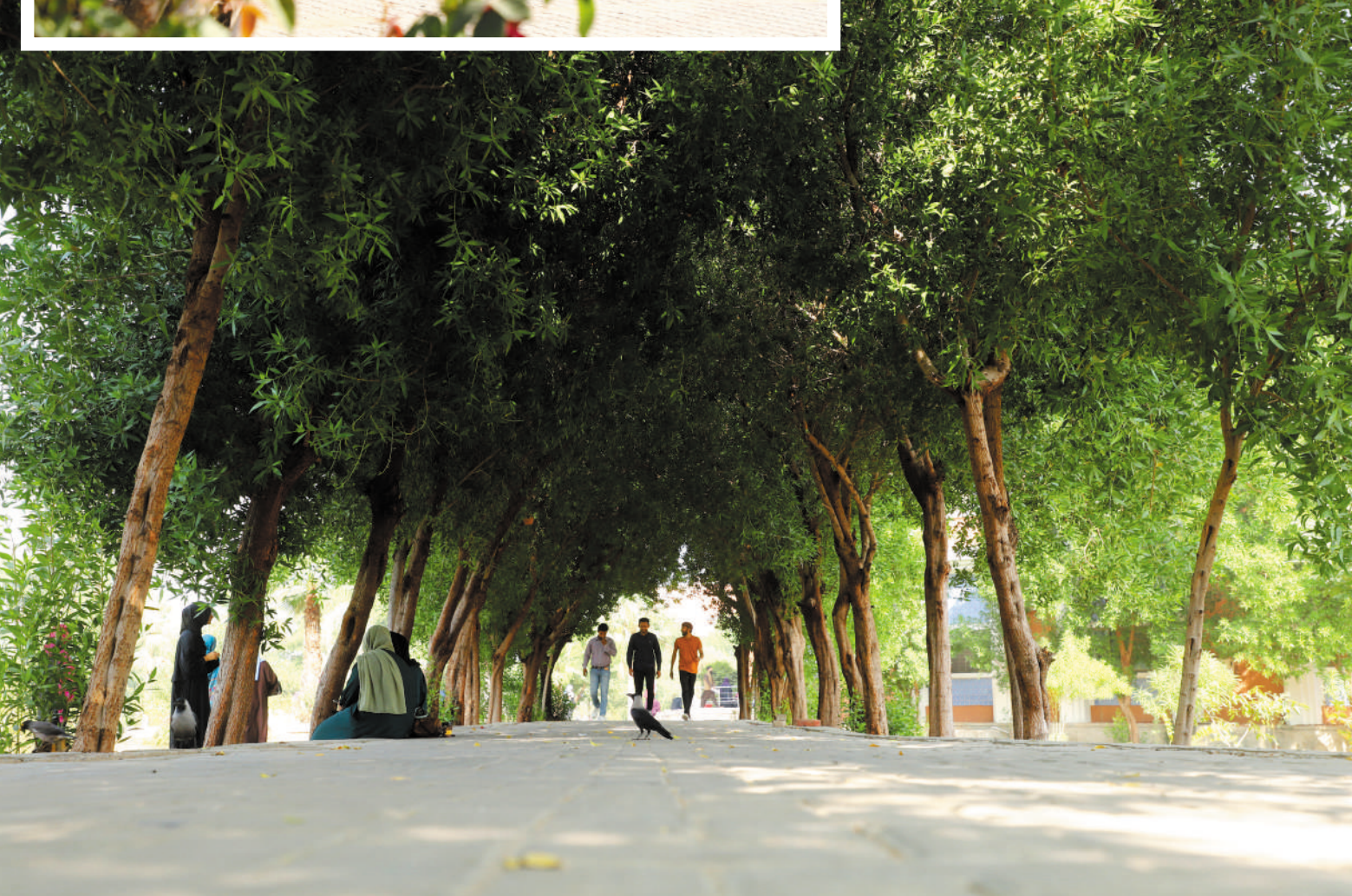

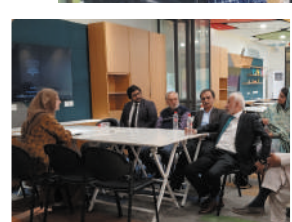

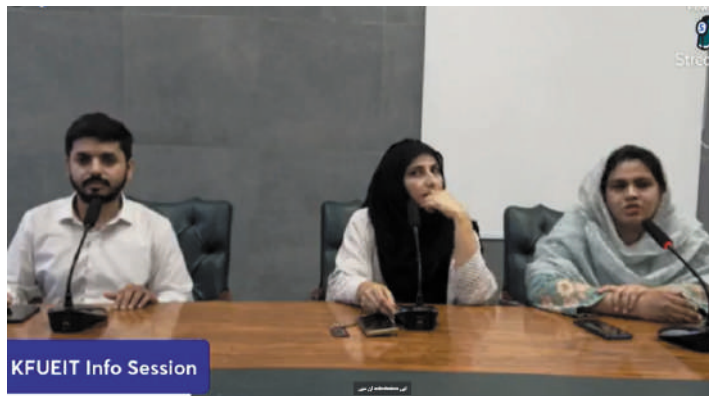


KFUEIT and District Press Club RYK Forge Media-Academia Partnership

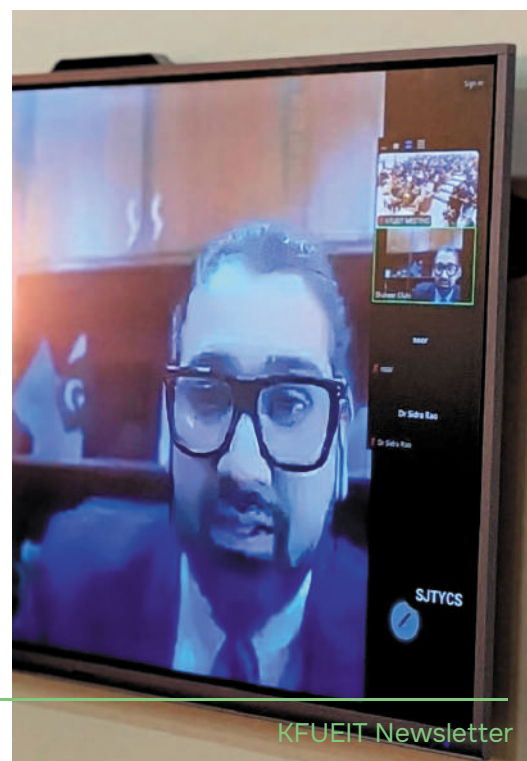

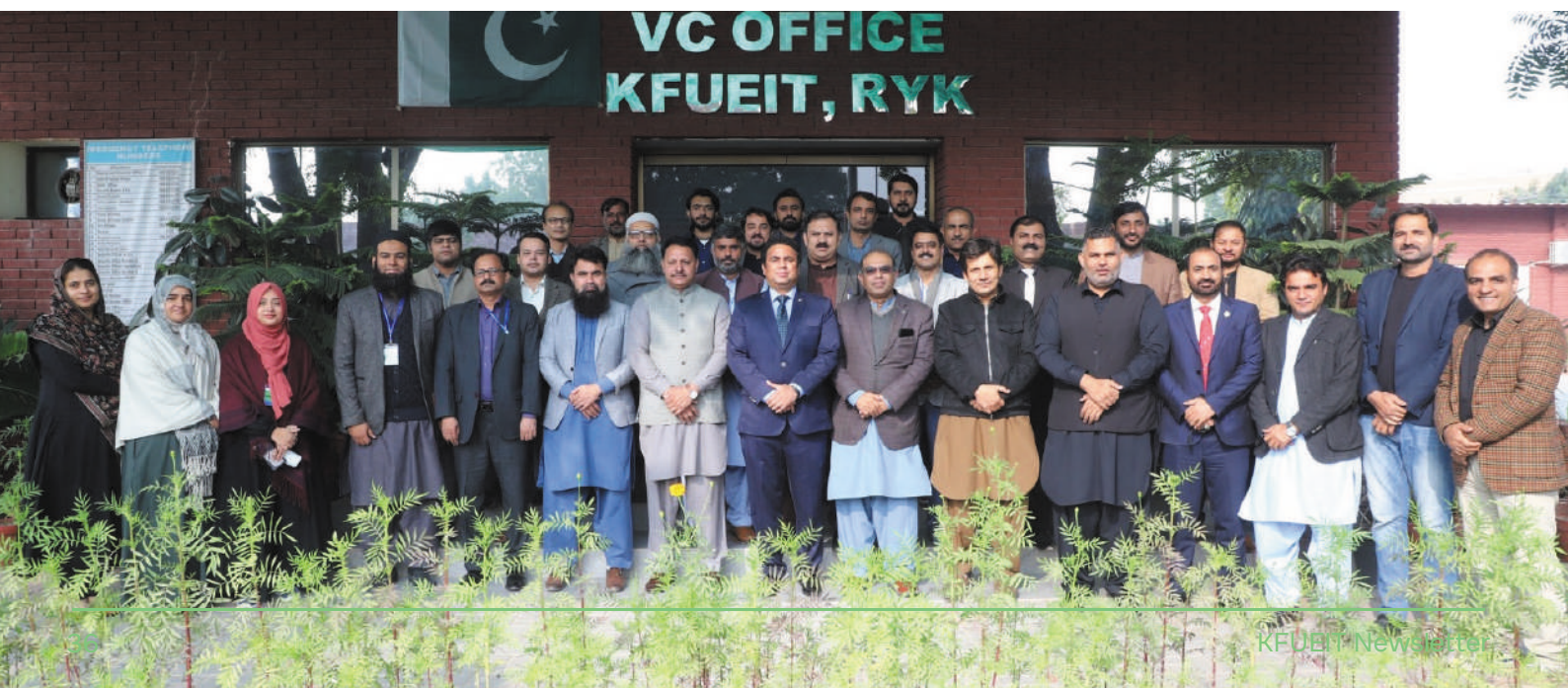
KFUEIT Successfully Concludes National Outreach Program for Faculty Training

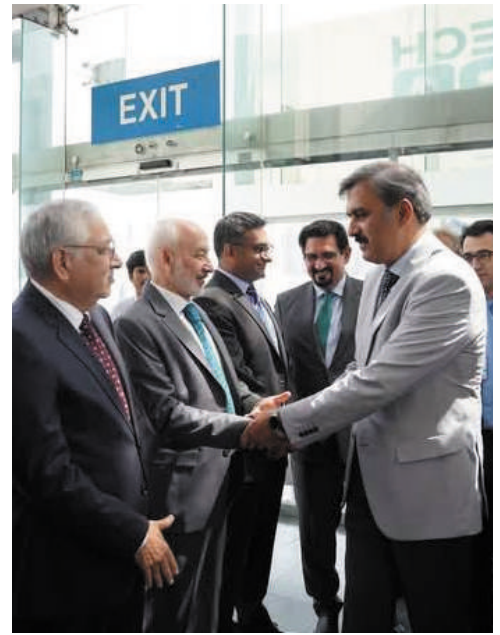
